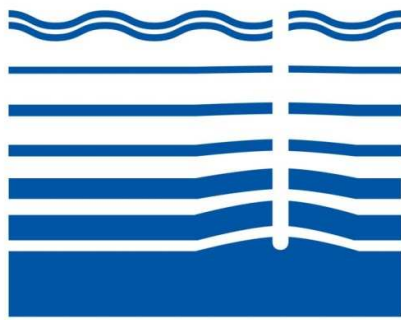

1. HARD COPY entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by Rory Scott, Lyons Holding, Lyons Road, Slinfold, West Sussex, RH13 0TD by no later than Friday 23rd December 2011. **Please include email address so draw can be sent out. If no email address you will have to contact the Referee for details of the draw etc. Start times will be as advertised on the entry form.**

2. The draw will be held on Saturday 7th January 2012.

3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received first out. Junior girls for the grade 1 girls event with greater than 1500 ranking points will be guaranteed entry if they apply before the closing date. If more than 12 girls with more than 1500 ranking points enter then they will be accepted last received first out. Please note that if you send your entry early and before the closing date you move into another Band the committee will automatically accept your entry against the new Band for which you qualify.

4. Competitors will be informed by email (if email address provided) of their successful entry in advance

5. Food & drink may be purchased at the leisure centre & there is ample free parking. There are showers & changing room facilities.

6. Play will take place on 18 Butterfly tables (If less entries the committee reserve the right to reduce the number of tables) with Butterfly nets and posts and with Tees Sports scoring machines.

7. Play will be with Butterfly 3 star white balls.

8. Tables will be individually courted. Min ceiling height: 10m; 18.Courts Size: 10m X 5m.

9. Lighting is general & strip luminaire lighting. Light intensity is 500 lux.

10. The venue has gran sprung flooring.

11. There will be no admission charge.

12. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points (but see regulation 17).

13. Prize money will be awarded as follows:

U-18 Girls Grade 1 – 1st = £500 cash, 2nd =£300 cash and 3rd = £100 cash, U-18 Mixed Grade 2 – 1st =£200 cash, 2nd =£125 cash, 3rd =£75 cash & 4th =£25 cash, U-18 Mixed Band 3 – 1st =£200 cash, 2nd =£125 cash, 3rd =£75 cash & 4th =£25 cash U-18 Mixed Band 4 – 1st =£200 cash, 2nd =£125 cash, 3rd =£75 cash & 4th =£25 cash, Bands 5 & 6- 1st = £100 Tees Sport voucher, 2nd =£75 Tees Sport voucher, 3rd = £25 Tees Sport voucher

Total Prize Fund = £2175cash and £400 in Tees Sport vouchers

14. The Entry Form will incorporate an Undertaking as follows:-

15. To observe the regulations of the tournament.

16 To abide by the decisions of the Referee.

17. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) on this entry form.

2. Every entrant must be Affiliated to ETTA Ltd as a Player Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.

3. Every player must hold a valid ETTA Player License or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to the ETTA Ltd.

4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.

5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11.

6. In the morning session each of the mixed bands will consist of 16 players split into two groups of 8. Each of the groups of 8 will play each other in round robin format. In the afternoon session the top 4 from each group of 8 will play the opposite top 4 and likewise the bottom 4 will play the opposite bottom 4. To calculate the overall position only matches between the top 8 players will be counted and for the bottom 8 only the matches between themselves will be counted. Each player will play 11 matches.

7. For the girls only event there will be a maximum of 12 competitors. In the morning session the 12 will be split into two groups of 6 competitors. In each of the groups of 6 everyone will play each other in a round robin to confirm an order of 1-6 in each group. In the afternoon session the top 3 from each group will play the top 3 of the opposing group and likewise the bottom 3 of each group will play the opposing bottom 3. To calculate the overall position only matches between the top 6 players will be counted and for the bottom 6 only the matches between themselves will be counted. Each player will play 8 matches.

8. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. If players pull out before the day we will try to find replacements. Players looking for scratch entries need to inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed is more risky.

9. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.

10 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel event if entries are low.

11. There will be no separate practice facilities. There will be no capacity for practice sessions after play begins at 08:45 Practice will be permitted between 08:00 and 08:45.

12. Competitors are required to umpire matches.

13. ETTA Appendix 'C' to Rules will apply.

14. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.

15. No gluing up will be allowed in the building.

16. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

17. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the ETTA computer ranking scheme (but see regulation 17).

18. Competitors must have been born in 1994 or later to qualify for the U-18 event.

19. The committee reserve the right to adjust banding thresholds if low entry is received.

20. The events will be mixed (i.e. males & females together). Where both players have less than 600 ranking points, then matches between players of the opposite gender will be for ranking points, but if either player has 600 or more ranking points, the match will not count for ranking points.
