Horsham Table Tennis Club, supported by Horsham District Sports Development, the Council's sports development team, is seeking to appoint a motivated individual to help run its new junior (9-12 year olds) youth club on Thursday nights in term-time at Greenway Academy in Horsham.

The youth club includes various sport, art and play activities. Horsham TTC is keen to develop a multisport opportunity, that includes table tennis, as part of a strategy to keep young people linked to table tennis but within a wider mix of opportunities and more on the children's terms.

The role will involve:

- Supporting the Youth Leader in Charge to run the club safely
- Help and join in as appropriate to support the participants to have fun in any or all of the sport, art/craft and play activities available
- Set out and put away club equipment
- Guiding positive and reasonable behaviour

Ideally applicants will have a good sense of fun, interest in the welfare and development of children, a responsible attitude and be comfortable in a noisy and energetic environment. An interest in sport/physical activity and/or art/craft pursuits will be advantageous. The postholder will be required to undertake a DBS check if aged 18 or over.

In return for their contribution the postholder will gain experience of working as part of a small team in an area of work many would consider enjoyable and satisfying. Personal training, development and support opportunities will be offered and this role could provide a potential boost to a CV in preparation for a career in a related area.
